
PERSON SERVED SPOTLIGHT

2024 CHILI COOK OFF

Haylie Price won the 2024 AccessAbility chili cook off competition! Check out her winning recipe below.

INGREDIENTS

4-5 chicken breasts, shredded
1-2lbs hot italian sausage and/or chorizo
1/2 yellow onion
4-5 cans fire roasted tomatoes
5 cans mild or spicy chili beans
1 large can tomato sauce
1 jar salsa
1 small block of Velveeta cheese



DIRECTIONS

- Cook and season chicken to your preference. Haylie used a pressure cooker and seasoned with Kinder's blend seasoning, Spicy Dano's and Meat Church fajita seasoning.
- Dice yellow onion and season to your preference; saute. Once translucent, add your sasuage/chorizo and cook until brown.
- In a large stockpot, add the chorizo/onion mixture along with shredded chicken, chili beans, tomatoes, salsa, and tomato sauce.
- Let simmer for 30 minutes. When ready to eat, dice up Velveeta cheese and mix in until combined.
